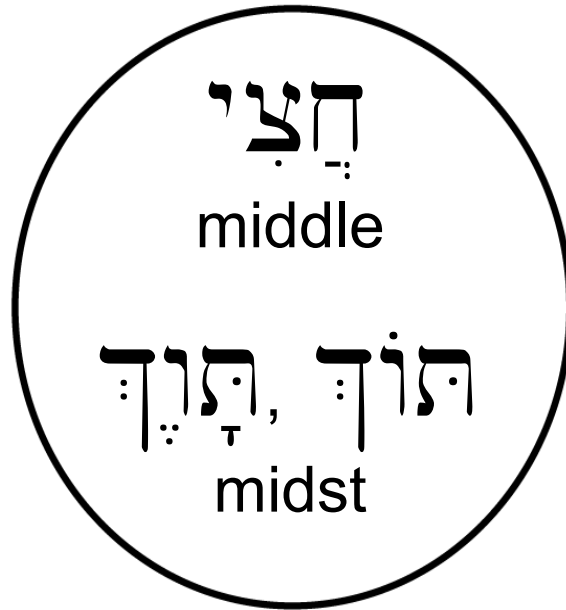
Note that in the Eastern World, maps were historically drawn with an eastern orientation, that is, with east at the top instead of north... thus north can be expressed as שְׂמֹאל (left) and south as יָמִין (right).
