HEBREW NUMBERS

- “sigla” means how the numeral is written in Classical Hebrew.
- In Classical Hebrew numerals, there is no sigla for zero.
- **cardinal numbers** are for **counting**, e.g. one, two, three, four... (think: cardinal and counting both start with c).
- **ordinal numbers** are for **ordering**, e.g. first, second, third, fourth... (think: ordinal and ordering both start with o).
